The Irish Centre Talented Youth

The Irish Centre for Talented Youth (CTYI) was established at Dublin City University (DCU) in 1992. The Centre provides highly stimulating weekend and summer programmes for hundreds of academically talented students aged 6-13 years and 13-16 years. Students take courses in areas as diverse as Archaeology, Chemistry and Engineering and are able to study at a pace and level appropriate to their ability.

In 2009-2010 Saturday classes will be offered in Dublin City University, Limerick and Cork and other centres nationwide for children aged 8-13 years.

Saturday courses will be held in DCU and Cork only for children aged 6-7 years.

CTYI also offers Wednesday afternoon classes in DCU for 8-13 year old students.

Assessments

All students wishing to participate in CTYI courses must first take an assessment in order to establish eligibility.

No preparation or revision is required. No materials are needed other than pencil and eraser.

Assessment locations, dates and times can be found overleaf. Sample questions can be found on our web site.

8-13 Year Old Assessment

- 3 tests: Abstract, Verbal and Mathematical Reasoning
- Children must qualify in one area to be eligible for CTYI.
- Assessment lasts 2 hours (including 10 minute break)

6-7 Year Old Assessment

- 2 tests: Abstract and Verbal reasoning
- Children must be able to read to take part
- Assessment lasts 1 hour.
- Children must qualify in one area to be eligible for CTYI

Results of the assessment are posted out as soon as possible after test date.

Assessment fee €45 (non-refundable)

To apply for Assessment

Complete and return the application form overleaf and post with €45 fee at least two weeks before test date. Details of the test centre and some sample questions will be posted to parents.

Evaluation of Psychologist's Report

Alternatively students who have been assessed independently by an educational psychologist may submit this report between 1st September – 31st May each year for consideration. The evaluation fee is also €45.

Courses

Courses are designed to be academically challenging and allow students to meet and mix with each other. All qualified students will be notified of exact dates/locations before the start of course.
